Where the best come to learn! For 26 years this full-contact camp has developed the character and the skill of young football players. Campers will receive the best in coaching and facilities. In 3 days there will be a total of 6 practices, leading to a controlled game/ scrimmage on the fourth and final day.

Campers will need a full set of football gear from a school or community program. Rentals are available through SFU but must be paid for at time of registration. In the registration confirmation letter there will be a detailed list of required equipment and items as well as detailed drop-off and pick-up information for both live-in and commuter participants.

**NOTE:** Participants in this camp must have a completed medical form with **DOCTOR'S SIGNATURE** prior to the start of camp. The medical form is available online and can be downloaded/printed from the website at: [www.sfu.ca/camps](http://www.sfu.ca/camps).

**For live-in campers:** Each day will consist of 2 practices, 3 meals (on the first and last day only one meal is provided), and supervised evening activities. They will enjoy a full university experience as they stay in SFU's individual campus residences and take advantage of the playing fields, athletic facilities, swimming pool and dining areas.

**For commuters:** Each day will include 2 practices and lunch (dinner on first day), as well as access to residence common areas during breaks. Every athlete will receive a crested camp jersey and report card.
